

GRAND CRU CLASSÉ 2016

REVUE DU VIN DE FRANCE VERY NICE TANNIC SHAPE, THE FLESH SEEMS TO BE SCULPTED IN THE CHALK, THE FRUIT 16/20 IS CAREFULLY PRESERVED. LIKE ITS NEIGHBORS ON THE LIMESTONE PLATEAU, THIS HISTORIC GROWTH WILL EMERGE WITH TIME.

TASTING BOOK DARK PURPLE RED WITH VIOLET HUE AND ALMOST BLACK CORE. EXPRESSIVE NOSE, MARKUS DEL MONEGO MULBERRIES AND ELDERBERRIES, FRESHLY GRATED DARK CHOCOLATE, VANILLA, 92/100 CARDAMOM AND GINGERBREAD. ON THE PALATE SWET FRUITS, FIRM BUT MATURE TANNINS, GINGERBREAD FLAVOUR AND VERY GOOD LENGTH.

WINE SPECTATOR ENTICING, WITH LOTS OF RED LICORICE AND WARM FRUITCAKE NOTES OUT FRONT, JAMES MOLESWORTH BACKED BY A GOOD CORE OF PLUM AND RASPBERRY PRESERVE FLAVORS, THIS HAS A 89-92/100 Fleshy Feel, Good integration and a relatively modest dose of toast through THE FINISH

WINE SPECTATOR A HIGH-PITCHED STYLE, WITH LOTS OF FLORAL LIFT TO THE MIX OF DAMSON PLUM, JAMES MOLESWORTH CHERRY AND BLACKBERRY FRUIT, WHILE LIGHT SANDALWOOD, TEA AND BERGAMOT NOTES 92/100 ADD DETAIL ON THE FINISH. A BIT ATYPICAL, AND LOVELY.

WINE DOCTOR IN THIS VINTAGE WE HAVE WHAT SEEMS TO BE THE TRADITIONAL BALESTARD NOSE OF SMENT.

CRIS KISSACK CHERRIES AND CHOCOLATE CAKE, RICH AND EXPRESSIVE, BUT NOT EXACTLY SUGGESTING 91-93/100 FRESHNESS AND LIFT, THE PALATE HAS THE SAME RICH, SMUDGED-FRUIT CHARACTER, WITH SUBSTANTIAL EXTRACTED TANNIC BACKBONE, SITTING AROUND AND DOMINATING A CORE OF PLUSH DARK CHERRY FRUITS, DAMSON, BLACKCURRANT AND BLACK PEPPER. DESPITE THE SWEET AROMATICS OF THE NOSE THE PALATE HAS THE LIVELY ACID PROFILE OF THE VINTAGE, BUT IT CAN'T COUNTER THE SUR-MATURE STYLE AND HUGE TANNIC WEIGHT. RIPE, A LITTLE BLACKCURRANT, MODERATELY DENSE STRUCTURE, SLIGHTLY ROUGH TANNINS The one thing it does have in its favour is a fairly seamless and glossy texture, AND THERE IS SOME SENSE OF ACID BALANCE.

VINOUS MAGAZINE ATTRACTIVE, MID-WEIGHT SAINT-ÉMILION THAT WILL DRINK WELL WITH MINIMAL CELLARING ANTONIO GALLONI RIPE RED FRUIT, TOBACCO, SMOKE, INCENSE, RED CHERRY JAM AND ROSE PETAL ALL 92/100 BUILD IN THE GLAS, WITH EXPRESSIVE SAVORY AND FLORAL TOUCHES, THAT ADD NUANCE AND LIFT. TODAY, THE 2016 IS QUITE PRETTY.









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THE WINE CELLARD INSIDER MEDIUM-BODIED AND SOFTLY-TEXTURED, THIS WINE DISPLAYS A WEALTH OF RIPE, DARK, 90/100 RED FRUITS, PLUM AND THYME WITH JUICY BLACK CHERRIES IN THE FINISH.

THE WINE CELLARD INSIDER FRESH HERBS, THYME, LICORICE AND RED PLUMS WORK TOGETHER IN THIS MEDIUM-BODIED JEFF LEVE EASY TO LIKE WINE. SOFT, FRESH AND JUICY, THIS IS QUITE ALREADY CHARMING.

WINE ENTHUSTIAST THIS IS A BEAUTIFULLY RIPE, FRUITY WINE WITH JUICY ACIDITY AND SOFT TANNINS. IT IS ROGER VOSS FULL OF BLACK CURRANT FRUITS JUST LIGHTLY SUPPORTED BY THE GENTLE TANNINS

BORDEAUX TOTAL OPULENT, SWEET, FAT, FRUITY BOUQUET, BLACKBERRY JAM, MOCHA CREAM, DARK RENÉ GABRIEL CARAMEL, VANILLA. PITHY, TART, BROAD PALATE WITH DENSE, SWEET FRUIT, SANDY TANNIN, 17/20 ANGULAR STRUCTURE, SWEET AROMATICS, BROAD, DRY FINISH.

PAOLO BARACCHINO DEEP RUBY RED HUE WITH PURPLE NUANCES. A NOSE DOMINATED BY AROMAS OF MY

90-92/100 FULLY RIPE CHERRY, INTENSE CYPRESS, VEGETABLE SKIN (THAT WHICH EVOKES THE SOFTNESS OF LEATHER), VIOLET, MINT, EUCALYPTUS, BLACK PEPPER, NUTMEG, RUBBER AND EPISPERM (THE THIN SKIN OF BOILED CHESTNUT). IN THE MOUTH IT OFFERS FLAVORS OF CHOCOLATE AND CHERRY. MEDIUM BODY, WELL BALANCED. THE TANNINS ARE ROUND, INTENSE, VELVETY AT THE ATTACK AND THEN GIVE A SUBTLE SENSATION OF DRYNESS AND BURNING ON THE UPPER GUMS. WINE THAT HAS LENGTH. THE 2015 TASTED LIKE MON CHÉRI, THE GRAPES WERE MORE RIPE. THE 2016 IS, IN OPINION, SUPERIOR TO THE 2015.

MATTHEW JUKES MINTY AND SPICY ON THE NOSE WITH HUGE OAK, TOO, THIS IS A DIFFICULT WINE TO 17.5/20 LIKE AROMATICALLY, BUT THERE IS A LOT OF FRUIT ON THE PALATE AND IT IS ROBUST AND INTENSE. THIS SHOULD WORK WELL GIVEN A DECADE.

JEANNIE CHO LEE A LIVELY, INTENSE ST EMILION RED WITH DARK PLUMS, COCOA BEANS AND BLACKBERRIES 93/100 ON THE PALATE, THE TANNINS ARE FIRM, RIPE AND VELVETY - PERFECT FOR LONG TERM AGING. THIS IS A VERY SUCCESSFUL BALESTARD LA TONNELLE THAT IS PREFECT FOR LONG TERM AGING - FEW DECADES EASILY.

B MY BORDEAUX RUBY. BLACKBERRIES, SPICES, RASPBERRIES, ELEGANT, NUANCED NOSE. FRESH ACIDITY, 92-94/100 RIPE TANNINS, FRUITY, DARKER BERRIES, SPICES, DETAILED, LONG.









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JANCIS ROBINSON A HINT OF VERY SWEET, ALMOST VANILLA OAK ON THE NOSE. THEN SAVOURY AND SOME 16+/20 DEFINITE OAK INFLUENCE ON THE PALATE, THE TANNINS ARE A BIT CHUNKY, DOESN'T QUITE HANG TOGETHER AT THE MOMENT THOUGH IT MAY DO EVENTUALLY.

JAMES SUCKLING ATTRACTIVE COAL SMOKE AND TARRY NUANCES WITH A DENSE ARRAY OF DARK-PLUM 93/100 AND BERRY AROMAS AND FLAVORS. THE PALATE HAS A RICH, PLUSH AND JUICY ARRAY OF DARK PLUMS. QUITE TANGY, VIBRANT AND POWERFUL FRUIT HERE.

IZAK LITWAR AROMATIC, A BIT OF REDUCTION, ON THE VERGE OF OVERRIPENESS, GOOD BALANCE. 90/100

GUIDE HACHETTE THE NOSE, OPEN AND SEDUCTIVE, IS VERY TYPICAL OF MERLOT (70% OF THE BLEND). WITH ITS NOTES OF BLACKCURRANT AND RASPBERRY, AROMAS THAT ARE FOUND IN THE MOUTH. SUPPLE IN THE ATTACK, TASTY AND STRUCTURED IN ITS DEVELOPMENT, THIS WINE BENEFITS FROM FINE AND TIGHT TANNINS. A HARMONIOUS WHOLE WHICH WILL AGE WELL.

GILBERT ET GAILLARD DEEP-HUED WITH GARNET HIGHLIGHTS. ELEGANT TOASTED VANILLA ON THE NOSE WITH 92/100 BEAUTIFUL JAMMY FRUIT PRESENCE. VELVETY, MOUTH-FILLING PALATE OFFERING UP DELICIOUS MELLOW FRUIT ASSISTED BY DELICATE OAK INFLUENCE, GOOD FRESHNESS, BALANCE AND SILKINESS.

GAULT ET MILLAU LIVELY FLORAL NOSE, BEAUTIFUL WOOD, VELVETY IN THE MOUTH WHILE KEEPING FRESHNESS, 17-18/20 DENSITY AND TANNINS, A SUCCESS.

B MY BORDEAUX RUBY, BLACKBERRIES, SPICES, RASPBERRIES, ELEGANT, NUANCED NOSE, FRESH ACIDITY, 92-94/100 RIPE TANNINS, FRUITY, DARKER BERRIES, SPICES, DETAILED, LONG.

FALSTAFF DEEP DARK RUBY GARNET, FIRM CORE, VIOLET REFLECTIONS, DELICATE RIM BRIGHTENING, PETER MOSER DELICATE FLORAL UNDERLAY OF RIPE BLACKBERRY FRUIT, SUBTLE HINTS OF LICORICE, FRESH 93/100 ORANGE ZEST. JUICY, CHOCOLATY TEXTURE, RIPE TANNINS, SPICY FINISH RIPE CHERRIES IN THE AFTERTASTE.

LE FIGARO DEEP-HUED WITH GARNET HIGHLIGHTS. ELEGANT TOASTED VANILLA ON THE NOSE WITH BERNARD BURTSCHY SUPPLE, CHARMING WITH TANNINS THAT ARE CERTAINLY PRESENT, BUT THE WHOLE IS 16.5/20 SILKY AND ACCESSIBLE. TASTING THIS WINE, ONE UNDERSTANDS BETTER THE LAMENT OF FRANCOIS VILLON WHICH APPEARS ON THE LABEL.









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DECANTER THIS IS AN ESTATE THAT HAS GONE LONG ON EXTRACTION IN RECENT YEARS AND JANE ANSON JUST ABOUT STOPS SHORT IN 2016. THIS IS STILL A CONTEMPORARY, BIG INTERPRETATION 91/100 OF ST-ÉMILION THAT PERFORMS SOME CLEVER SLEIGHT OF HAND TO STOP BEFORE THE WALL. DRAMATIC AND ENJOYABLE, WITH NOTES OF LIQUORICE AND BLACK OLIVE PASTE.

BETTANE ET DESSAUVE A WINE WITH A STRONG CHARACTER, WITH A VELVETY TEXTURE THAT IS BEGINNING TO 16,5/20 TAKE SHAPE, WITH AN INTENSITY THAT IS TYPICAL OF THE VINTAGE. IT IS ABSOLUTELY NECESSARY TO WAIT FOR IT.
